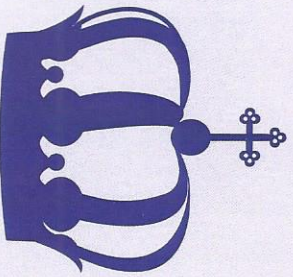


The King's Daughters
